

## What barriers have you had for implementation?

1	Recently there have been stricter regulations on using photographs containing patient health identifiers.
2	Multiple Information Technology permissions had to be granted, including: giving medical assistants access to the electronic medical record, allowing installation of electronic medical record software to departmentally owned mobile devices, and allowing multiple users access for a single mobile device.
3	Finding a source of light which is bright enough to allow visualization of the uvula without causing discomfort to patients and still leave the medical assistant's hand free.
4	Teaching appropriate technique for the medical assistants and incorporating photography into their current work load and flow. They have required periodic re-education on technique to maintain high quality photographs.
